(And Finally)

Many people are recognizing that in our culture there is an all-out assault against anything that could be regarded as traditional or conservative. For years there has been an undermining of what is known as the nuclear family, which was once regarded as the foundation block of a stable society. One of the latest moves by companies, I have found rather insulting. Emails received offered me the option to opt out of Father's Day marketing as it is a "a difficult time for many people"!! Why has Father's Day received such treatment? I am sure many people find Mother's Day or Valintine's Day difficult, but we don't get the opportunity to opt out of the marketing for them. To treat Father's Day this way is to demean the very nature of fatherhood. We know that in this fallen world there have been many terrible fathers and many people have been hurt and abused by men who sinned appallingly, but all the wrongs of the bad can only ever be healed by the knowledge of the Heavenly Father revealed to us through Jesus Christ. Father's Day is just another commercial construction and whether we celebrate it or not is immaterial, but the Fatherhood of God is a glorious spiritual truth that is worthy of celebration constantly. Earthly fathers are not the supreme model, God is, and He delights when His children come to Him.
